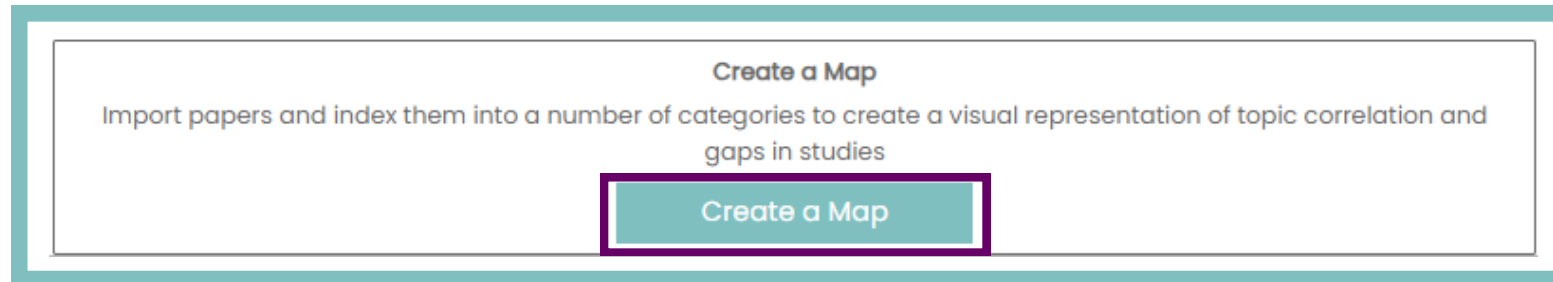



Add a new Map

After creating a new project, you will see an option to create a map.



Once you click on “Create a Map”, a detail page will load up.

Fill in the fields. “Display name” and “Slug” are required fields.
