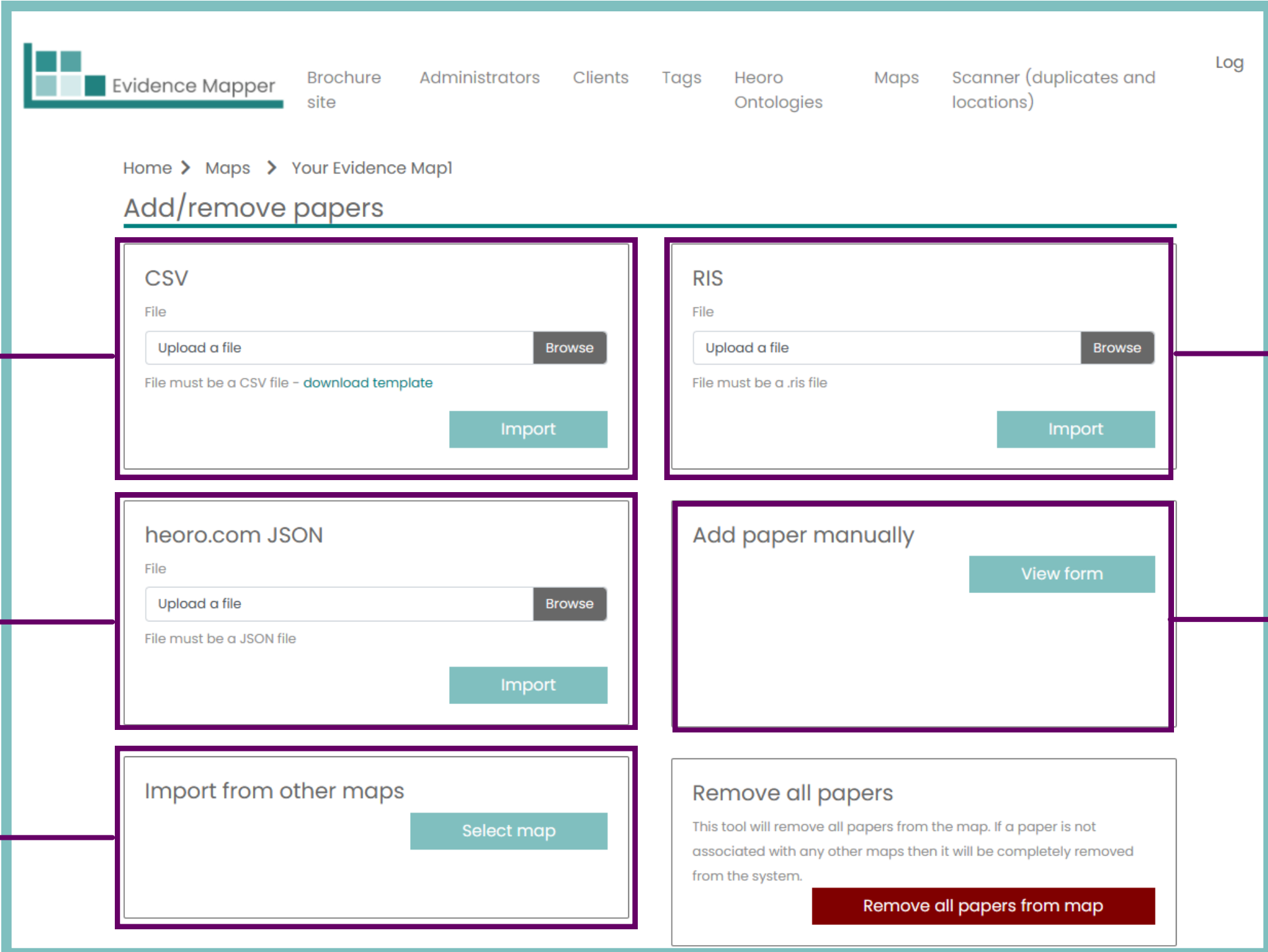


# Importing Papers to an Evidence Map

After the “Pages” screen, you will come to the “Import Papers” page. You have multiple options to import papers.
