


# Selecting fields for indexing

Shared fields

This is a list of pre-selected fields. You can remove these by clicking Edit and then remove from Map.

You can also “Remove all tags from all papers on this map” and also “Remove a field from this map”.

Any tag/field that has been removed cannot be recovered.

You can also add a new field by entering the name. You have the option to share this field with other maps if you think this field would be relevant in other project or maps. This will show in shared fields when it has been added. Once completed, click “Add field to Map”.
